



**MANUFACTURER'S LIMITED WARRANTY**  
**PLACE N' GO™ RESIDENTIAL**

**1. GENERAL LIMITED WARRANTY PROVISIONS:**

**Limited Residential Warranties** – These Limited Residential Warranties provided by SelecTech, Inc., (the “Manufacturer”) apply to PLACE N’ GO branded floor tile product (the “Flooring Product”), and consist of the General Use Limited Warranty and the Defects Limited Warranty, as further described below. Other than as referred to in Section 3 below, the General Use Limited Warranty and the Defects Limited Warranty as described below are the sole and exclusive warranties provided by the Manufacturer to which these Limited Residential Warranties apply.

**Who May Claim** – These Limited Residential Warranties are provided solely for the original end-consumer (as described below) of the Flooring Product and are not transferable. See Section 4 below for further details.

**General Use Limited Warranty** – The Manufacturer warrants as follows:

For twenty five (25) years from the date of purchase from an authorized vendor and subject to the conditions set out below, the Manufacturer provides the following General Use Limited Warranty to the ordinal purchase for properly installed and maintained Flooring Product:

- 1) The surface layer of the Flooring Product will not wear-through under normal use conditions,
- 2) The Flooring Product will not be damaged due to exposure to water, and
- 3) The Flooring Product will not delaminate.

**Defects Limited Warranty** – Separate and apart from the General Use Limited Warranty above, the Manufacturer warrants for a period of six (6) months from the date of purchase of the Flooring product that the Flooring Product will be free from manufacturing defects. Manufacturing defects are defects other than those referred to above under the general Use Limited Warranty and do not include defects caused during shipment or by improper handling, installation, use, storage, maintenance and/or care, as these are defined in the installation instructions and maintenance and care instructions. Reasonable variation in shade and color are not considered defects.

**Conditions to Warranties** – Each of the General Use Limited Warranty and the six-months Defects Limited Warranty is provided subject to the following conditions:

- 1) The Flooring Product must be installed properly in accordance with the installation instructions. The Flooring Product must be maintained in accordance with the care and maintenance instructions. Both sets of instructions were provided to you when you purchased this Flooring Product. If you need an additional copy of either, please call 1 877-738-4537.
- 2) The Flooring Product must be used only indoors, in climate controlled, residential areas and must be subject only to normal residential traffic conditions, to the exclusion of heavy furniture, casters, and footwear or other spikes or small surface contact areas. Floor protectors should be used under such conditions, as unwarranted permanent denting of floors should be expected if floor protectors sized appropriately to the weight and contact surface area of the furniture are not utilized. These Limited Residential Warranties do not apply if the flooring is used in any commercial setting.
- 3) Damage to the Flooring Product must not have occurred as a result of abrasion, exposure to excess heat or cold, ice, gaseous or aqueous chemicals, scratching, impact or cutting, or contact with a transportation system, such as motor vehicle or riding mower, and the like.
- 4) The surface layer of the Flooring Product will not be considered to have worn-through unless the gray or black material below the décor surface is readily visible and is at least one (1) square inch (5.45 square centimeters) in size. Gloss or sheen reduction is not considered to be surface wear and shall not be a breach of or covered by the above limited warranties.
- 5) Delamination is a separation of a layer of a product from one or more adjacent layers due to inadequate bonding between product layers at the time of manufacture. Separation of product layers due to tearing, for example from singular or repeated impact or abrasion, is not considered delamination.
- 6) The color of the surface layer of the Flooring Product may change or fade slightly over time to exposure to, e.g., direct sunlight, exposure to some household and industrial chemicals, and natural and synthetic rubber. Therefore, color changes over time are to be expected and shall not be a breach of or covered by the above limited warranties.
- 7) Although the Flooring Product will not be damaged by exposure to liquid water, exposure of liquid water can result in the growth of mold or mildew on the Flooring Product and adjacent materials. Such growth and damage resulting therefrom shall not be a breach of or covered by the above limited warranties.
- 8) The Limited Residential Warranties do not apply to accessory products, such as moldings or the like.

Both the General Use Limited Warranty and the Defects Limited Warranty shall be void and shall cease to apply if one or more of the above conditions are not complied with.

**Apparent Defects** – Flooring Product with apparent defects should not be installed. If at the time of installation of the Flooring Product there are one or more apparent defects present in the Flooring Product, both the General Use Limited warranty and the Defects Limited Warranty shall be void to the extent of such defects, and any claims arising directly or indirectly under the above warranties shall be rejected.

**2. HOW TO MAKE A CLAIM:**

Any claim under either of the Limited Residential Warranties describes above must be made within the applicable warranty period by contacting the Manufacturer with 30 days after the basis for the claim is detected.

Proof of purchase in the form of a purchase receipt, showing, at least, the date of purchase and description of Flooring Product purchased must be presented to make a claim. The Manufacturer reserves the right to designate a representative to inspect the Flooring Product and the underlying

floor and remove samples for analysis. If the person making a claim under any of these Limited Residential Warranties fails to provide reasonable cooperation to the Manufacturer's representative and permit such representative to carry out such inspections and remove such samples, the Manufacturer shall be under no obligation to provide any of the remedies described below.

**3. MANUFACTURER'S RESPONSIBILITY:**

Remedies And Process – If the Manufacturer accepts a claim under either of the Limited Warranties described above, it will repair or provide replacement Flooring Product, at its option, with respect to the defective Flooring Product. Repaired or replaced Flooring Products are only warranted for the time remaining under the original warranty periods, if any. If the Manufacturer in its sole discretion determines that such repair or replacement is not appropriate, it may choose to refund the purchase price of the defective Flooring Product. If the specific Flooring Product for which a claim is made is no longer available, the Manufacturer will replace the defective Flooring Product with another design of equal or greater value at the Manufacturer's discretion. Upon approval of the warranty claim, the Manufacturer will provide the claimant with instructions on the manner in which to proceed in order to have the Flooring Product repaired or replaced, and the claimant must comply with such instructions within ninety (90) days after the claim is approved, failing which the claimant's right under the limited warranties will be deemed waived.

The above remedies are the sole and exclusive remedies for claims arising out of or relating to the Flooring Product.

Both the General Use Limited Warranty and the Defects Limited Warranty give you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

**4. DISCLAIMERS:**

The following disclaimers, limitations and exclusions are made to the extent that they are permitted under applicable consumer protection legislation, sale of goods legislation and similar legislation. Some jurisdictions do not allow such disclaimers, limitations and exclusions, so they may not apply to you.
